LOCATION: 31st Fighter Wing, Commander's Office/CC, Aviano Air Base, Italy

MAJOR DUTIES: The primary purpose of this position is to perform assistant work and to support the installation Local National (LN) Safety and Occupational Health Manager in a number of safety and occupational health program elements such as safety inspections/surveys, assessments, mishap investigations, safety training and briefings in accordance with (IAW) Italian Legislative Decree and subsequent provisions. Is for the safeguard of serviced 31st Fighter Wing (31 FW), Geographically Separated Units (GSUs) and tenant employees' health and promotion of safety conditions in the work environment. Assists and follows the Safety and Occupational Health Manager instructions in meeting Italian/European Safety Law practices to carry out the Safety and Occupational Health Program in a timely and efficient manner, promoting prevention measures, actions and safe behavior. Participates to periodic inspections, evaluations and surveys of facilities, equipment and operations in order to assess employees' safety and health risks and corrective actions. Performs risk assessment of the hazardous processes/conditions identified; evaluates potential or actual consequences and analyzes applicable methods for controlling or eliminating hazards. Documents inspections/site visits findings and prepares reports. Elaborates with the support of the Safety and Occupational Health Manager prevention and protection measures as outcome of the risk assessment. Identifies appropriate measures to eliminate or control hazardous operating procedures and ensure safe conditions in the work environment in accordance with applicable safety norms. Within the area of competence reviews plans for new constructions, building demolitions, upgrade or changes, equipment replacement or installation. Identifies possible safety and health hazards and recommends changes not included in original project plans. Provides recommendations to eliminate or control safety hazards in the repair and maintenance of installation facilities and equipment ensuring also a potential emergency management. If needed, attends preconstruction conferences and briefs contractors on safety requirements. Collaborates with offices, such as 31st Wing Safety, Judge Advocate, Civil Engineer, Aerospace Medicine, Contracting Squadron, Civilian Personnel, to include Base Competent Physician and appointed Employees Safety representatives (ESRs) regarding comprehensive occupational health matters affecting serviced LN employees. Considers local and higher command instructions and policies as well as those formulated by other U.S. Federal Government Agencies and safety standards adopted by national safety associations, societies or institutes in performing risks assessments and supporting the Safety and Occupational Health Program development. Assists the Safety and Occupational Health Manager with mishap and/or hazardous conditions, evaluations and investigations such to define origin, causes and contributing elements. Assists the Civilian Personnel Flight (CPF) and the Competent Physician in scheduling medical appointments for all 31 FW, GSUs and tenant serviced LN employees on the basis of the risk assessment, job performed, age and previous Competent Physician's prescriptions. QUALIFICATIONS: Interested applicants must possess 1 (one) year of specialized experience equivalent to at least the next lower grade level and which has equipped the applicant with the knowledge, skills and abilities to successfully perform the duties of the position to be filled. To be creditable, specialized experience must have involved: (1) identifying, preventing or eliminating safety hazards in work methods or environmental conditions; or (2) safety training or promotion. Such experience must have provided a practical knowledge of occupational and environmental safety hazards, survey techniques, and control and preventive methods.

SUBSTITUTION OF EDUCATION FOR EXPERIENCE: 4 (four) years above the High School level or 3 (three) years of Italian university with courses related to safety, fire prevention, industrial hygiene or other directly related subjects. Applicants must submit a copy of their certificate from a recognized university, listing all the exams and grades.

Good command of the English language is required, subject to testing.

Applicants must possess a valid Italian driving license type "B".

Experience which is not on file at the closing date of the announcement will not be considered.
